



ICD-10 Z Codes for Social Determinants of Health

To help track and address our members' social needs, we encourage you to use Social Determinants of Health (SDoH) ICD-10 Z codes on the claims you submit to Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Texas (BCBSTX). Any clinician can document a person's social needs, including physicians, nurses, social workers, community health workers, case managers or other providers.

What Are Social Determinants of Health?

Social determinants of health are the economic, social and environmental conditions beyond health care, and the structures, cultures and technologies that influence a person's health, care and well-being. These non-medical drivers of health **impact health equity**, the fair and just opportunity for everyone to achieve their optimal health.

Using SDoH ICD-10 Z Codes

Each patient brings more to your office than the symptoms they present on the surface. SDoH may affect a patient's ability or willingness to follow their recommended treatment plan. It's important to adopt a "whole-person" approach. Working together, we can help remove barriers to better health and help improve our members' quality of life. With ICD-10 Z code data, we can better understand our members' unique social needs and help connect them with resources.

What You Can Do

- Educate staff on the need to screen, document and code data on patients' SDoH needs.
- Ask about SDoH needs. Patients may not know to discuss non-medical issues with health care providers and may need to be prompted.
- **Document** any SDoH needs and assign the appropriate ICD-10 code to report on claims.
