99281, 99282, 99283, 99284, 99285: Emergency department visit

RATIONALE:

Emergency department visit codes, 99281-99285, may be allowed separately when submitted with a surgical procedure on the same date of service by the same provider who performs a surgical procedure. This allows the physician to be compensated for the history and physical necessary when a patient is seen in the emergency department, and requires surgery on the same day. Other Evaluation and Management codes submitted in conjunction with a surgical procedure on the same date of service will be denied as part of the surgical package.
