To better track and address the social needs of this population, we invite you to incorporate Social Determinants of Health (SDOH) ICD-10 Z codes on the claims you submit to us. Any clinician (physician, nurse, social worker, community health worker, case manager, or other providers) can document a person's social needs.¹

What are Social Determinants of Health?

Social determinants of health are conditions in the environments in which people are born, grow, live, work, and age. These social factors can impose significant barriers to a person's health and wellness.

Using Social Determinants of Health ICD-10 Codes

What does this mean for you and your staff? Each patient brings more to your office than the symptoms they present on the surface. SDOH may affect a patient's ability or willingness to follow their recommended treatment plan, so it's important to adopt a "whole-person" approach. By working together, we can remove barriers to improved health and help provide a better quality of life to members.

Through the utilization of ICD-10 Z code data, BCBSTX will be able to better discover the unique, social needs of our members and help connect members with available resources.

What You Can Do:

- Educate staff on the need to screen, document, and code data on patients' social needs.
- Ask patients about their SDOH needs.
 Patients may not know to discuss non-medical issues with their provider and may need to be prompted.
- Document any SDOH needs by utilizing the SDOH ICD-10 codes listed on the following page on the claims you submit to us.
