Key Term	Definition	
Electronic Visit Verification (EVV)	Is a computer-based system that electronically documents and verifies service delivery information, such as date, time, service type and location for certain Medicaid service visits.	
21st Century Cures Act	The 21st Century Cures Act is a federal law enacted by the U.S. Congress in December 2016. This law requires all states to use EVV for Medicaid personal care services (PCS) and home health care services (HHCS) requiring an in-home visit that are provided under a State plan or under a waiver of the plan.	
EVV Aggregator	A centralized database that collects, validates, and stores statewide EVV visit data transmitted by an EVV System	
EVV Claims	Program Provider or Financial Management Services Agencies (FMSA) must only submit claims for reimbursement once all the visits for the claim line items have been completed and accepted by the EVV Aggregator. EVV Aggregator will perform a claims match against the accepted EVV visit transactions stored in the EVV Portal. The payer must not pay a claim without a matching accepted EVV visit transaction stored in the EVV Portal.	
EVV Compliance Oversight	A set of standards established by the Texas Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) and managed care organizations (MCOs) to ensure EVV requirements and policies are being followed	
EVV Policy Handbook	The Texas Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) handbook that provides EVV standards and policy requirements	
EVV Visit Maintenance	Is the process used by the program provider, FMSA or CDS employer to correct an EVV visit transaction in the EVV system to accurately reflect the delivery of service.



• 21st Century Cures Act

 The 21st Century Cures Act Section 12006 (Cures Act) is a federal law requiring Electronic Visit Verification (EVV) for all Medicaid personal care services; including services delivered through the consumer directed services option and the service responsibility option.

- EVV System Availability Reports
- The EVV System Availability Report provides the total hours the state EVV Aggregator, state EVV Portal, and state approved EVV vendor systems are unavailable, malfunctioning, or not accessible. Pursuant to Rider 148, HHSC will make this report available by the 10th day of the month.
