

# Reminder: Texas Medicaid Providers Help Ensure Our Members Don't Lose Their Coverage

## Reminder

As you may know, the public health emergency (PHE) related to COVID-19 ended March 31, 2023. States now have to recertify the eligibility of all Medicaid/CHIP enrollees.

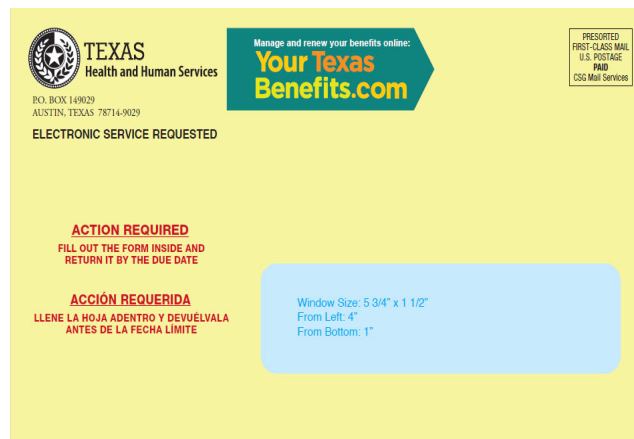
Those who no longer meet eligibility requirements or those who do not take the steps to confirm their eligibility – **will lose their coverage**.
