

Alert: Case Management for Children and Pregnant Women (CPW) Effective 09/01/2022

What is New

Effective September 1, 2022, Case Management for Children and Pregnant Women (CPW) will become a Medicaid benefit. Children birth through 20 years of age with a health condition and high-risk pregnant women of any age will receive health-related case management services. Case managers help members gain access to needed medical, social, education and other services.

Case Managers

Who can become a case manager?

- Physician Offices
- School
- Health Departments
- Counseling agencies,
- Health clinics
- Other types of agencies that employ licensed social workers or RNs can provide case management services.

Interested social workers and nurses must meet all eligibility requirements. Individuals and agencies must apply with the Department of State Health Services (DSHS) and enroll with Medicaid.
