

# Updated 03/01/2022 | Posted 04/14/2020 COVID-19: Rural Health Clinics (RHC) and Telehealth/Telemedicine – Texas Medicaid

# What is changing?

The <u>Texas Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC</u>) is extending the end date for RHC telehealth and telemedicine reimbursement **through March 31, 2022.** 

We are continuing to evaluate the evolving state and federal legislative and regulatory landscape relating to COVID-19 and will continue to update our practices accordingly.

# Will RHCs be reimbursed for telehealth/telemedicine?

Yes, per the <u>HHSC</u> Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Texas (BCBSTX) Medicaid will reimburse RHCs as telemedicine and telehealth distant site providers statewide for service dates **from March 20, 2020 through March 31, 2022.** 

# How should RHCs bill for reimbursement?

RHCs should submit claims using current RHC procedure codes T1015 and 99381.

# Should a modifier be billed?

Yes, providers should use **modifier 95 with place of service 02** to indicate the occurrence of remote delivery when delivering service.
