



Specialty Pharmacy Vendors (Pharmacy Benefit)

Specialty medications that are U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) approved for self-administration are typically covered under the member’s pharmacy benefit. Some members’ plans may require them to obtain these medications from a specific preferred specialty pharmacy for benefit consideration and will not provide benefits for any self-administered drugs dispensed by a physician. Please call the phone number on the member’s ID card to verify coverage, or for further assistance or clarification about your patient’s benefits.

Please note: Before these drugs may be covered, additional review and prior authorization may be required. Some plans may not cover these prescriptions if not filled at an in-network specialty pharmacy provider.
