What is new?

On November 10, 2020, the American Medical Association (AMA) announced new procedure codes for the COVID-19 vaccines and vaccine administration. On December 18, 2020, the Food and Drug Administration (FDA), issued Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) for the use of the Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine for COVID-19 vaccine and vaccine administration codes.
