
Is it diagnostic or preventive?







Do you know the difference between **preventive care** and **diagnostic care**? It can help you get the right care at the right time — and save you money.

Preventive care

Preventive care includes recommended annual vaccinations, wellness exams, and routine screenings and tests. It's focused on keeping you healthy and preventing illness and disease. Your TRS-ActiveCare plan covers preventive care visits at 100%.

Diagnostic care

This type of care focuses on diagnosing and/or treating chronic conditions or other health concerns. It includes things like monitoring symptoms and ongoing pain management. Discussing symptoms of a new or existing condition can also be diagnostic care.

IMPORTANT TIPS

- During your preventive care visit, ask your provider if your concerns fall under diagnostic care. That way, you won't end up with a surprise bill at your no-cost preventive appointment.
- Choose a Primary Care Provider (PCP) and have an annual wellness exam for a better chance of staying healthy. TRS-ActiveCare Primary and TRS-ActiveCare Primary+ plans require a PCP. TRS-ActiveCare 2 and TRS-ActiveCare HD plans strongly encourage a PCP.
